End of Course Testing

End of Course Tests – End of course examinations will be given in English I, English II, English III, Algebra I, Algebra II, U.S. History and Biology I. The final exam grade will count 25% of the student's final grade in the courses taken.

EXPLORE, PLAN, and ACT Testing

Students will take the EXPLORE test in the 8th grade, the PLAN test in the 10th grade, and the ACT test in the 11th grade.

Graduating with Distinction

Students may graduate with distinction if they attain a "B" average or above and complete at least one of the following:

- Earn nationally recognized industry certification
- Attend a Governor's School
- Participate in one of the Tennessee All State musical organizations
- Selected as a National Merit Finalist or Semi-finalist
- Score a 31 or higher composite ACT score
- Earn 12 or more hours of college credit

Graduating with Honors

Students who score at or above the benchmarks on the **ACT** test or the equivalent on the **SAT** test will graduate with honors. The **ACT** benchmark scores are as follows: English score 18, Math score 22, Reading score 21 and Science score 24.
